1 Adachi Museum of Art

Adachi Museum of Art is a prominent Japanese art museum housing 1,500 works of modern Japanese paintings, such as those by Taikan Yokoyama, contemporary Japanese paintings, ceramics, wood sculptures and lacquerworks. The museum also features large and magnificent Japanese gardens that allow visitors to enjoy the various expressions of the four seasons throughout the year. Consisting of six gardens such as the Dry Landscape Garden, the Moss Garden, the Pond Garden and the White Gravel and Pine Garden, the museum's gardens have been ranked number one in the "Japanese Garden Ranking" every year since 2003 by an American magazine specializing in Japanese gardens.

3 Kiyomizu-dera Temple

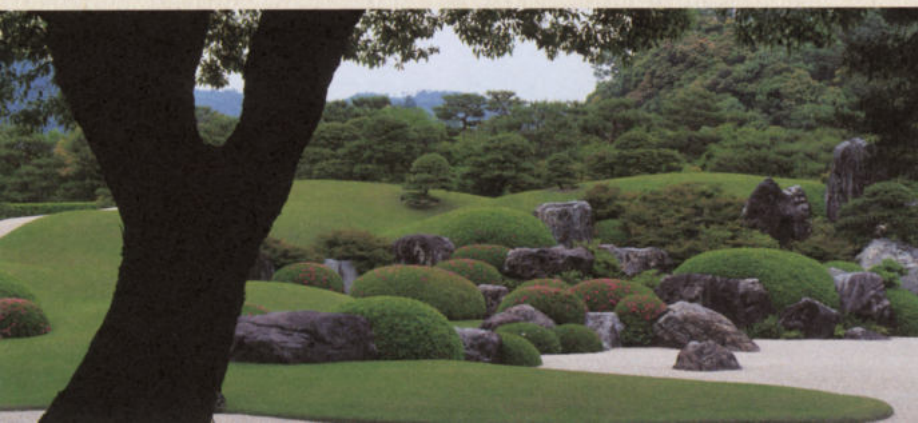
